Caring for babies and children from 3 months to 5 years

Fee Schedule for Funded Sessions from January 2020

All children have access to the Government Free Childcare sessions from the term following their 3rd birthday.

The current entitlement is a minimum of 570 hours per year for all children and a maximum of 1140 hours per year for children of working parents (conditions apply). It is not a requirement to access all of your entitlement.

We offer this entitlement in blocks of 1 full day at 10 hours each for a total of 51 weeks. Our pattern of delivery is every week day from 7am-5pm or 8am-6pm.

First priority is given to parents on a 51 week basis in terms of space, space, choice of days from 7am-5pm or 8am-6pm and are charged monthly. Parents are entitled to all the additional services and can make changes to their attendance with one months' notice. The space is guaranteed for the duration of their time at Elan.

The following monthly rates apply for those children accessing the Free Childcare Sessions:

We do offer Free Funded Hours but spaces are offered on a Monday and Friday only and is only guaranteed a month before the term starts and only for one term at a time. Children do not benefit from all the additional services and have to bring their own meals and snacks. Only five free spaces are offered each term and priority is given to children who receive the 2 year funding. No additional hours/sessions can be accessed.

*Please be aware that the government has set certain restrictions and the hours (regardless of 570 hours or 1140 hours) only covers childcare and no other additional services such as a cook, meals, resources and equipment, early years education, additional staffing, tools for planning e.g. footsteps, cleaning etc.
